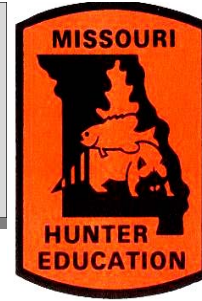

Smittybear Fund for Youth Hunting Recruitment and Education

Application

Requirements.....

Requests for funds shall be made at least fifteen (15) days prior to any regularly scheduled Association Board meeting. These dates are published in the MHEIA Newsletter.

Requests shall be made to the MHEIA Regional Director in the region where the event is to be held, or was held, for presentation to the MHEIA Board of Directors.

If applying for funds after the occurrence of an event, receipts, a written story and pictures of event outcome must be presented at the time of request for funds. Approval or denial shall be at the discretion of the MHEIA Board of Directors.

Funds *shall only* be used for youth hunting recruitment, and youth hunting education activities. Youth shall be defined as anyone age 06 through age 17. Youths, age 11 through age 15 need not be Hunter Education certified but is strongly recommended. Adult guardians are required to be present for each youth participating in youth hunting activities. Any adult participating in the actual hunt must supply their own, firearms and ammunition, bow and arrows and/or supplies. All participants and mentors will be responsible for and are required to have any and all Missouri Department of Conservation required permits and Hunter Education certification where applicable prior to any hunting or trapping activities. All participants must have a written consent/ hold harmless form signed by a parent or legal guardian and notarized by a Notary Public of the State of Missouri before any event sponsored or conducted by MHEIA.

After an event is held, person(s) requesting funds shall provide to MHEIA, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the next scheduled Board meeting, a written story and pictures as to event outcome and must present receipts for items purchased with these funds. Person(s) may request to make an in person presentation of the event to the MHEIA Board of Directors.

Please Print Clearly

I have my permission to participate in the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT organized by the MISSOURI HUNTER EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS ASSOCIATION, a nonprofit corporation, to be held ... I acknowledge that the youth participant has studied and understands the safety procedures and the rules of conduct for this event.

The youth participant wishes to participate in the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT organized by the MISSOURI HUNTER EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS ASSOCIATION. I understand that this event will emphasize safe firearms, bow and arrow or trap handling and will provide the opportunity for participants to pursue and harvest wild game.

I understand that by participating in the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT organized by the MISSOURI HUNTER EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS ASSOCIATION the youth participant will be engaging in a shooting sport that involves the use of firearms, bow and arrows or animal traps. I understand that there are risks associated with the use of firearms, bow and arrows and traps, including serious personal injury and death. By participating in this shooting/hunting event, the youth participant and I agree to assume all risks of personal injury and property damage.

In exchange for and as a condition of the youth participant being permitted to participate in the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT organized by the MISSOURI HUNTER EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS ASSOCIATION, I and the youth participant agree to the fullest extent allowed by law to assume all liability for any personal injury or property damage that may occur as a result of the youth participant's participation with the MISSOURI HUNTER EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS ASSOCIATION and to release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue any sponsor or organizer of the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT, or any persons associated with hosting the event, including property owners, affiliated gun or sportsman's clubs, nor any officer, director, employee, agent, or volunteer, from any and all liability or claims that may be suffered by the youth participant or a third party, directly or indirectly, in connection with or arising out of the youth participant's participation.

I voluntarily agree to the fullest extent allowed by law to indemnify, hold harmless and defend (including payment of reasonable attorney's fees and cost) any sponsor or organizer of the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT organized by the MISSOURI HUNTER EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS ASSOCIATION including property owners, affiliated gun or sportsman's clubs, nor any officer, director, employee, agent, or volunteer, from any and all liability for any damage or injury to any third party arising out of the youth participant's conduct while participating in the HUNTING EDUCATIONAL EVENT.
