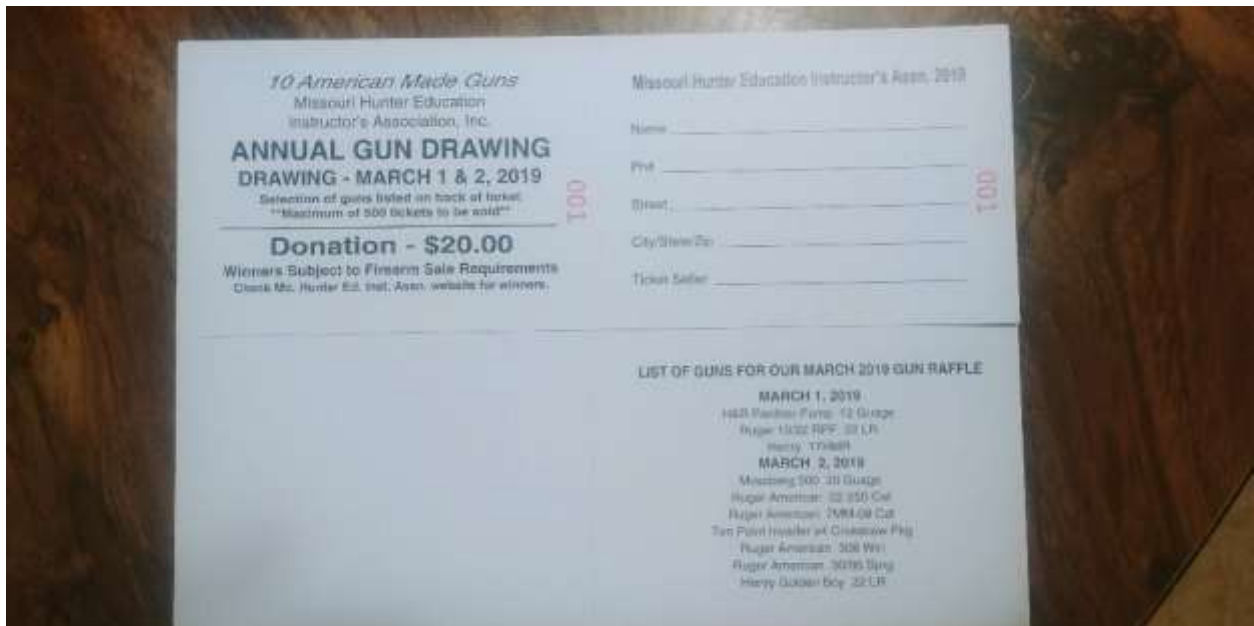

We attended an update on bears, elk, and wild feral hogs. There are around 300 elk now. When the herd gets to around 500, they will start a hunting season. The bears are around 300. When they get to 400, they will start a hunting season. We also attended the discussion on MDC's R3 plan to recruit, retain and reactivate hunters. I believe we should try to help in any way to recruit new members.

Frank Powers is currently working on our by-laws. I have also attained a book on grant writing to help us out. We are holding another gun raffle. We have 9 firearms and 1 crossbow. Bow season is here, however I have not been hunting yet.
